Mog and Pauline at Warwick Books do a lot of work promoting reading in the community and as we are doing the same here with our Newburgh community, it is lovely for us to be able to support each other and work together.

The book gifting arrangement we set up last Christmas is again available so members of the Newburgh community can purchase books from Warwick Books and gift them to Newburgh at a reduced price.

Whilst there is no expectation of gifts, we know that at Christmas and the end of the school year some parents choose to buy gifts for school staff and some teachers buy gifts for the children in their classes. What this arrangement offers is a chance for those gifts to be books for our library or classrooms for the children to enjoy.

The staff in each year group have made a book wish list for classroom book corners based on books they feel their class would enjoy. There are some lovely suggestions covering a wide variety of books and topics! We have also made a list for the school library.

All you have to do to make a book donation (or a donation towards a book) is select the book you would like to gift and then complete the book gifting form. Your completed form should then go to Mog or Pauline at Warwick Books. You can do this in person, over the phone or by email. Mog and Pauline will then arrange everything for you. The book wish lists and copies of the form are being emailed with this letter, **they are available from the school website** and forms can also be collected directly from Warwick Books.
