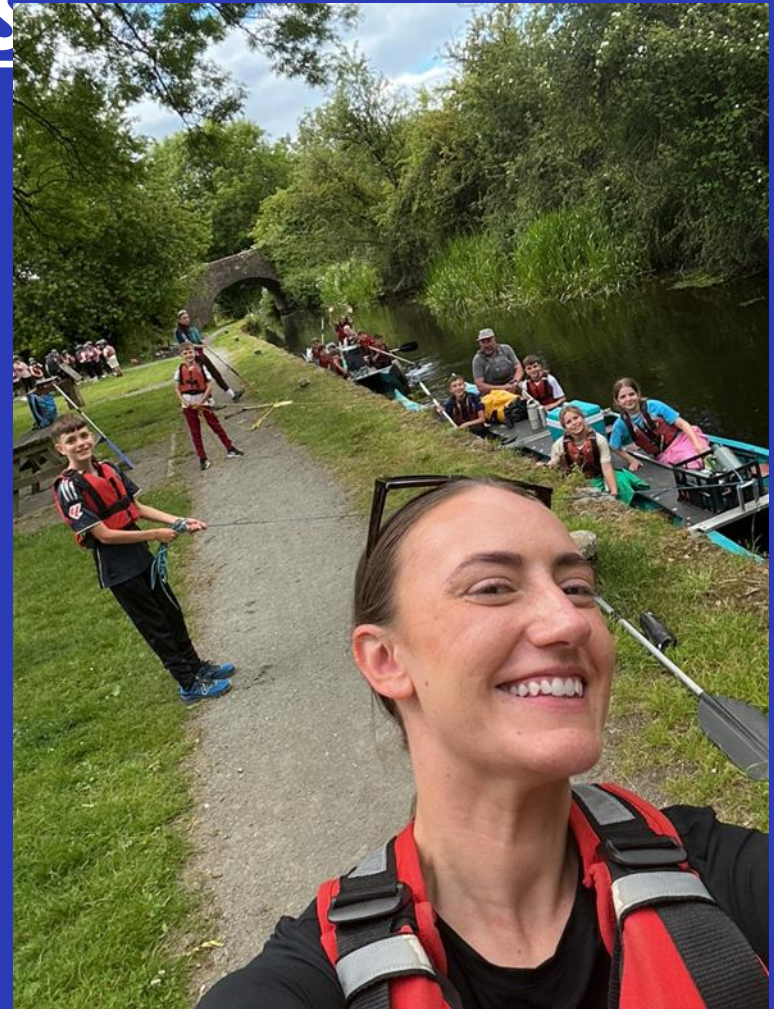
What do we do there?

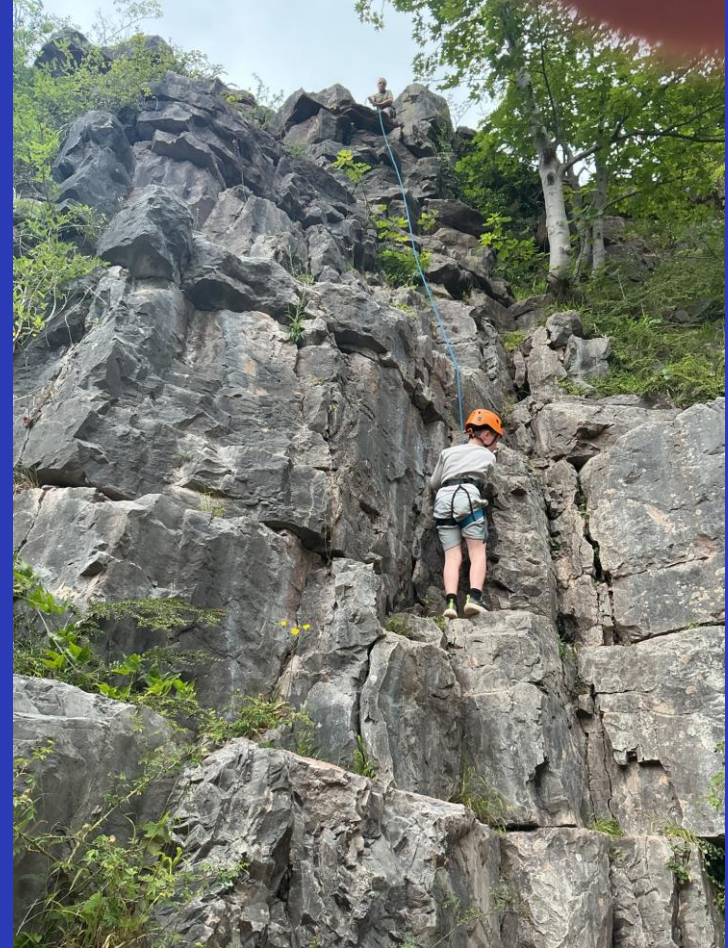
- Archery

What is it like there?

- Red Ridge is a purpose built facility.
- The bedrooms sleep 4 – 6 people, all located on the same floor.
- Showers and toilets are located beside or along the corridor from the bedrooms.
- Highly trained instructors.



Meals

- Fully cooked breakfast and cereal
- Children prepare their own packed lunch
- Evening cooked dinner
Hot and cold drinks always available
- Evening activities planned for the children – Night walk, movie, disco

Who will be going?

- Adults from school.
- Any children in Year 6.



What do you need to provide?

A kit list which is broken down into activities, will be available and will be added to the school website page.



Archery and Indoor Caving

- Long sleeve top and long trousers/joggers. Arms and legs must be covered during these activities. Indoor caves can get hot.

Kayaking

- Water shoes or old trainers which can get wet. Clothing that will get wet - leggings, shorts, joggers and a top. A thin jacket or long sleeve top is recommended if the weather is cold. Swim shorts could be worn and a swimming costume under clothes.

High ropes

- Comfortable clothing which your child can move around in such as joggers, shorts and leggings. No crop tops as the harness will rub.

Evening activities

- Comfortable clothing, long sleeve trousers and top recommended as there are midges at evening.

Bike ride and Bell Boating

- Comfortable clothing which your child can move around in such as joggers, shorts and leggings. No crop tops. Joggers or leggings may want to worn for biking to stop stings and bramble cuts.

What's included?

The cost of £452 includes:

- All food and drink
- Accommodation
- Activities run by qualified staff
- Safety equipment
- Coach Travel



Payment

Deposit (Non refundable)	Monday 2nd November	£110
Instalment 2	Monday 1st February	£110
Instalment 3	Monday 1st March	£110
Instalment 4	Monday 5th April	£122

The cost for the visit will be no more than £452 (exact cost to be confirmed once initial deposits and numbers received).

This cost includes transportation by coach, including the two days of off-site activities which are undertaken. This cost also covers all tuition, accommodation, equipment, food and insurance. The only extra that you will be asked to provide will be optional pocket money of £10.00, to be brought in on the day of departure.

Insurance - you may wish to take out insurance in case of cancellation or withdrawal.

Letter will be sent out to you with details tomorrow and a form to show interest. When deposit is paid your place will be confirmed.

Help with payment if necessary can be sought from the Head Teacher or the school office. There is a criteria to be met but we can signpost other support and communities as well.

How can you help prepare your child?

- Children will be expected to...
- Shower themselves
- Be able to fully dress themselves e.g. tie own shoelaces, comb/tie up own hair
- Make their own packed lunch including making sandwiches
- Be responsible for filling own water bottle
- Be responsible for their own belongings e.g. keeping their area of the dormitory tidy
- Be able to settle themselves to sleep at night time
