On week beginning 17th November 2025 an artist Anthony James will be working with children from Newburgh and our local community to create some artwork for the school hall!



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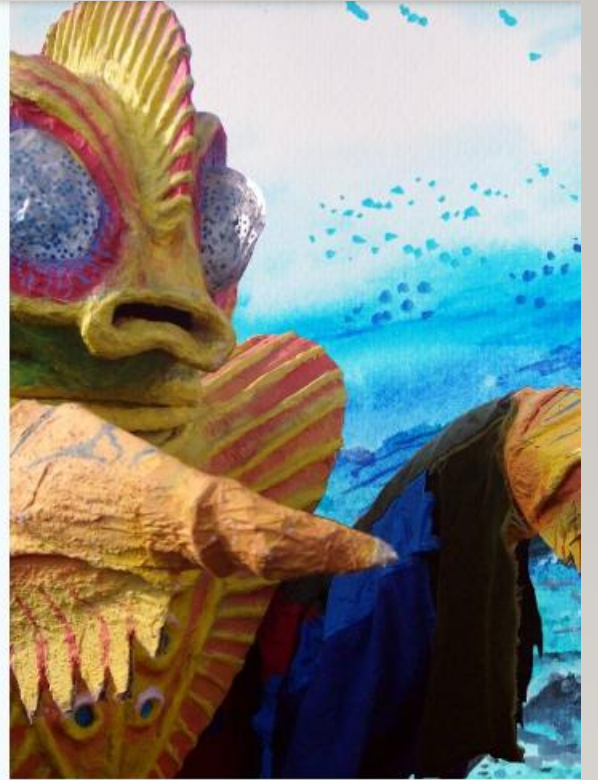
Anthony James works as a set designer for TV and theatre. He has designed over 50 amateur and professional productions such as Oliver and A midnights summers dream!

He has been a designer for Nintendo games

His work has appeared in Jurassic World Fallen Kingdom and in Cbeebies Junk Rescue.

In 1992 Anthony started his own company called Creaturama running mask and model making workshops in over 400 schools across the country. He also created three popular touring exhibitions of his work called 'Creaturama Universe' (based on aliens and monsters), 'Creaturama Dinosaur' (based on prehistoric creatures) and 'Creaturama Legends' (based on ancient myths and legends). Both Universe and Legends have appeared on BBCTV's 'Blue Peter' and all three exhibitions have broken attendance records at galleries nationally.





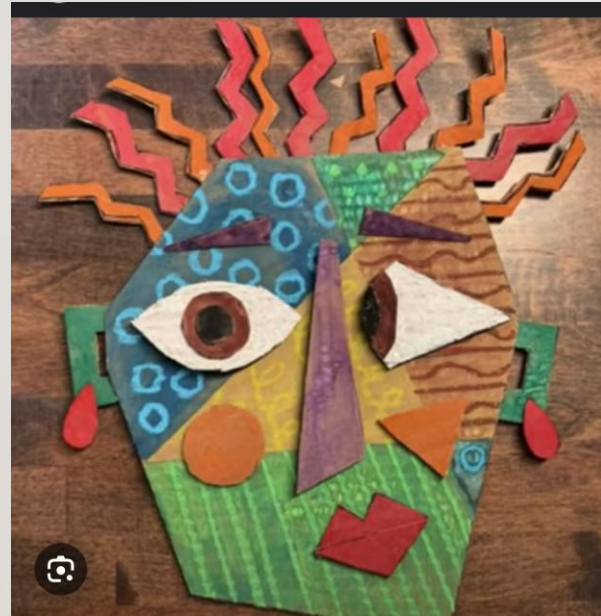




A lot of Anthony James' work is made out of recycled materials.
