

Remote Learning baseline provision

Year 3

Live sessions	Each day the exact times for the lessons can be found on the Calendar function under MS Teams. You can join the lesson by clicking on join from the calendar. Be prepared to engage with the teacher.
Pre-recorded sessions/ recordings of the live sessions	Each class has a channel called Recorded Lessons, click on the top bar, on the class name. Under this channel you will find any pre-recorded sessions and the live sessions when the teacher has uploaded them.
Assignments	Assignments are uploaded and available each day. The subject and date will name the assignment. You can find them under assignments or in each subject's channel. There will be a reading, writing and maths work daily, Music and RE assignments on a Wednesday, and other activities such as science or topic work during the week.
Files	Under the spelling's and times table's channels you will find files relating to these subjects for children to complete. This work does not need handing in and can be done flexibly during the week.
Chat	Children can use the posts/chat function to help each other when the teacher is not available. Any posts need to be related to their school work. We do not expect children to place videos, emojis and write anything inappropriate.
Marking and feedback	As a school we use a mix of individual feedback to ensure engagement and whole class feedback to support collaboration, peer and self-reflection. We will feedback individually if a child has not understood the concept in reading, writing or maths.
Deepening learning	Some children will require more work to provide them with a good level of challenge. Maths - the children will be encouraged to show a depth of understanding through our questioning in the lesson and how we model in our teaching. Dive Deeper opportunities are also provided in the lesson. English - children will be provided with the opportunity to develop their ideas through vocabulary, sentence structure choices or extended tasks. Reading – there will be a variety of reading tasks to suit the levels of individual readers.
Supporting children	Some children will require more support to understand the concept or activity. Children will be given the opportunity to ask questions and discuss ideas with their peers as they would be able to do in class.
