Ideas to support your child's learning at home
Our learning this term will be done through the theme of My World

To support reading:

- Try and read everyday
- Talk about the story read – can children retell the story in their own words?
- Read non-fiction texts about different habitats – forests and oceans

To support communication and language:

- Encourage children to respond appropriately by asking questions
- Discuss new words and vocabulary and encourage children to use this
- Offer explanations for why things might happen

To support physical development:

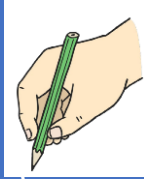
- Support to use a tripod grip when holding a pencil to draw and write
- Practice using small tools including scissors and cutlery
- Encourage them to develop strength, balance and coordination e.g. riding a bike

To support personal, social and emotional development:

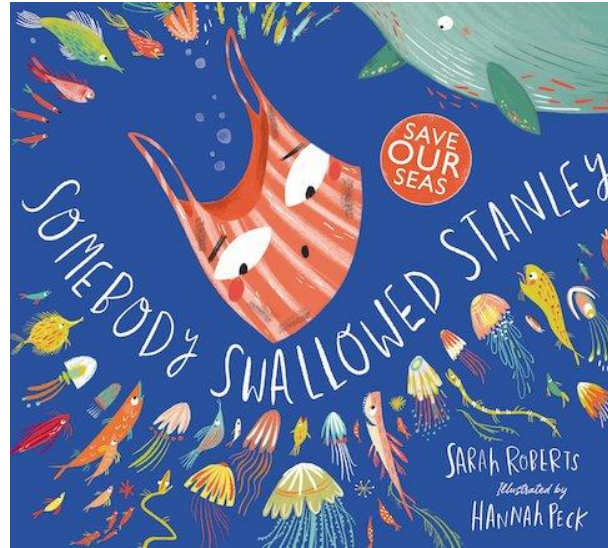
- Work and play cooperatively with others
- Be confident to try new things and show resilience and perseverance when faced with a challenge

To support writing:



- Support them to know how a tripod grip is formed
- Encourage children to write for a purpose forming their letters correctly
- E.g. make a save our seas poster

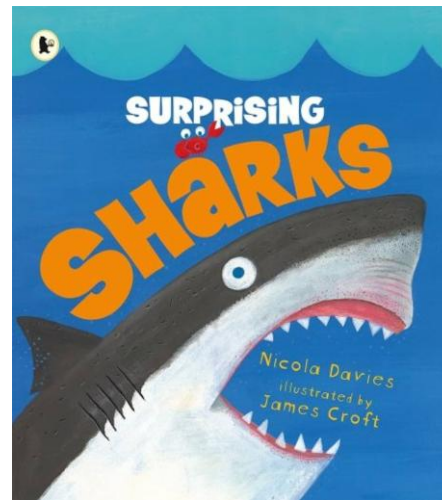


To support maths:

- Explore sharing and grouping – are the snacks shared equally? How do we know?
- Can children identify odd and even numbers? Can they explain how they know?
- Explore patterns and pattern rules

To support understanding of the world and expressive art and design:

- Know some similarities and differences between the natural world around them and contrasting environments
- Make and use props and materials when role playing
