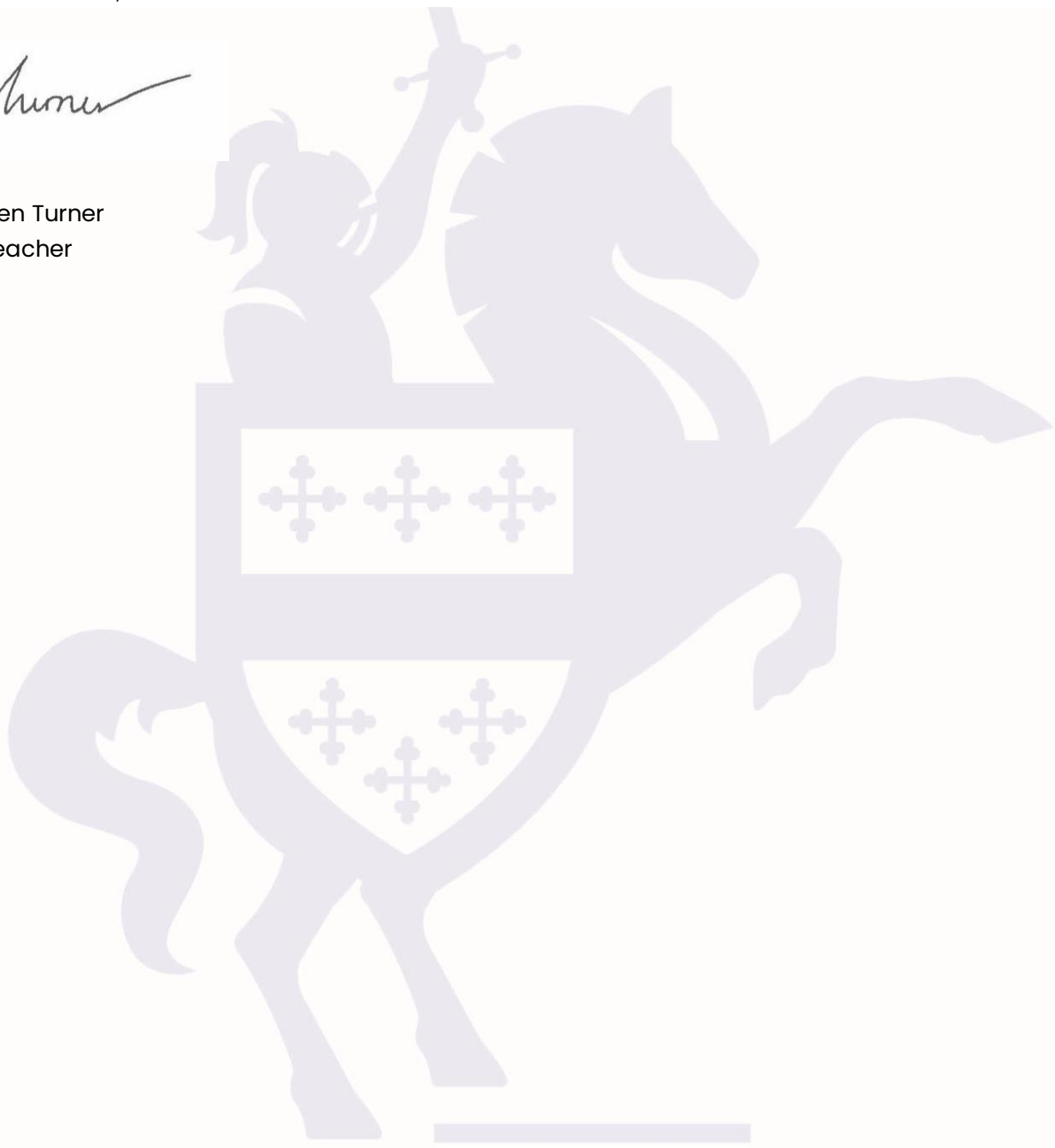
Last day of term
