Dear Parents, carers and reception children,

The children have all made a fantastic start at Newburgh and we are really looking forward to an exciting year in Reception. At the beginning of every half term, you will receive a link to the website with information about the current curriculum topic and learning taking place in school.

One of the main things we teach early on in Reception is for children to become more independent in looking after their belongings. Inevitably there will be items that get mislaid throughout the school day, so please ensure that all items are <u>clearly named</u> so we can return them to correct owner as soon as possible.

What do children need to bring to school?

This half term children need to bring their school book bag into school every day.

Children will need a named water bottle and a warm/waterproof coat.

In the first few weeks, children will choose a class library book (picture book) to share with you at home. Please keep this inside your child's book bag as it will be changed each week. You will also receive information shortly about our new digital reading diary to complete each week.

Snack and milk

Children do not need to bring a snack into school as this is provided for them.

Children are entitled to free milk at school until their 5th birthday. You must register for this so we receive the correct number of cartons per day. The website is Cool Milk: <u>https://www.coolmilk.com/</u>

After their 5th birthday, there is an option to pay for milk to continue.

Beginning and end of day arrangements

Thank you for bearing with us while we get used to new faces and a busy playground at the end of the day. We are so proud with how sensibly the children are coming in and leaving school.

Just a reminder that any notices / change to pick up arrangements should be sent via the school office – you can pop in anytime, call or email this in. It does make it tricky for children to enter the reception class safely if we have a queue of parents at the door trying to pass on messages and occupying staff who are manning the door. Thank you for you support with this.

Accidents

We understand that some children may have toileting accidents in school and we are very used to this, so please don't worry if this happens. If children do have an accident or come home in some of our spare clothes for any reason, please could you wash and return to us as we can quickly run short of supplies.
